## Introduction



#### Who Are We?

Arise began internship and Ministry School programmes in 2007, with a mission to equip and disciple the future ministers of New Zealand. By 2022, it became clear that our Ministry School needed revision. After much prayer and consultation (within and outside of Arise), we began in earnest to review and consider the future of our ministry training ground. This involved a significant revamping of our curriculum, policy, and structure to provide a development programme that created a healthy environment for our students to thrive. Our mandate is to raise ministers for the church of New Zealand and the world. We believe in developing a new generation of leaders who are equipped to go out and be who God has called them to be.



#### What does Arise Believe?

#### **The Bible**

We believe that God inspired the Bible, the Old and New Testaments, and that it guides our whole lives, directing all matters of belief and practice. It is trustworthy, authoritative, and applicable. The Bible, perfect as inspired by God, is still living and powerful in its entirety.



#### **The One True God**

We believe that humankind is loved by the one holy and eternal God who is the Creator of all things. He exists as the Godhead of three persons with distinct functions: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit.

#### Jesus - God the Son

We believe that the Lord Jesus Christ, fully divine & fully human, was sent of the Father to reconcile us to Himself. Jesus, born of a virgin, lived a sinless and selfless life, took our place in death through the cross, and demonstrated His victory over sin and death when He rose again on the third day and is seated on the right hand of God on high.

#### The Holy Spirit – God the Spirit

We believe that God intends for us to be given a new relationship with Him and new life through the work of the Holy Spirit at the point of salvation and for us to live filled with the power of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is sent by God, The Father and The Son, to equip us as the body of Christ with various spiritual gifts to glorify Jesus by transforming people, to convict of sin, and to help us live holy and fruitful lives in God's redemptive plan.

We believe in the continuation of the gifts of the Holy Spirit and encourage believers to pray for these gifts to operate in their own lives and to use them in building up the Church.

#### **Humanity**

We believe that God created man and woman, His perfect design, with each person uniquely formed in His image and given a purpose as part of His redemptive plan for all creation. All humanity is united in its origin, in its wilful fall in sin and alienation from God's life. All humanity is united in the offer of God's redemption from the resulting physical and spiritual death. In God's redemptive love, all humanity then equally warrants love, forgiveness, and just treatment.



#### **Salvation**

We believe that God offers all people the gift of eternal life and redemption from our fallen state, from death, which is the result of our sin, and from suffering eternity separated from God.

We believe that people can enjoy this assurance of being saved, by grace through faith in Jesus Christ. This faith affirms the redemptive power of Jesus' blood shed on the cross and that those receiving His offered gift are born again, justified, restored, and adopted into the family of God to receive eternal life to come. To be forgiven of our fallen sinful state and take our place in God's new creation each of us must repent of our sins, believe in the Lord Jesus Christ as our Saviour, and submit to Him as Lord of our lives. `The genuine result of a decision to follow Jesus Christ is a commitment to live a sanctified life of obedience to His Word.

#### **His Church**

We believe that, as recipients of God's grace and salvation, we are members of the body of Christ - His Church. As Jesus builds His Church we are to continue, as colabourers, meeting together and encouraging each other in the love and good deeds He calls us to, including preaching the gospel, baptising those who believe, and remembering Jesus as we share communion. Each member of the Church is a minister who should use their gifts as part of God's plan in demonstrating His love to the world.



#### **Our Mission**

We believe that our mission is to demonstrate and proclaim the love of God, that has changed our lives, to the rest of humanity. We are to inspire all people that they and their cultures are to be reconciled to God and honour Him by living according to His Word. The church of Jesus Christ is to actively work at positively transforming the world, through to Jesus promised return, the resurrection of the dead, and eternity with Him as King of every tribe, nation, and tongue in His new heavens and new earth.

#### What is Arise Ministry Academy?

The Arise Academy will train and equip a new generation of disciples, pastors, and leaders in the Church who feel called to full-time ministry. Our goal is clear and simple: by the end of your two years at the Arise Academy, you will be ready to go into full-time ministry. In collaboration with our academic partners, Laidlaw College, the Arise Ministry Academy will provide the necessary tools and practical training experience to produce world-leading and world-changing ministers.

An academy is a place where you learn, develop, and grow in your calling so that you can walk out ready to achieve your God-given dreams. We are a place where people come with a dream and become someone who can achieve that dream. We offer a variety of courses that challenge students to grow in their spiritual gifts, operate with increased effectiveness in ministry, and deepen their understanding of the Bible. Whilst practical learning is a key focus for all students, an even greater importance is placed on spiritual input. An integral part of the programme is developing a deeper relationship with Jesus, which includes taking part in worship and receiving discipleship from Arise Pastors and leaders.

### Second Year

#### **Locations**

All Campuses

#### **Key things you will learn**

- Practical ministry skills
- Laidlaw study (optional)
- Missions' trips
- Practical experience.

Students will choose a stream (Pastoral, Outreach, or Creative) and be assigned to a supervisor.

Spend time in your chosen stream developing skills and knowledge in this area.

#### What you will come out with

- Arise Academy 2nd Year Certificate
- A qualification from Laidlaw College (if applicable)
- Built CV, ready to work in ministry.



Students need a solid foundation to be prepared for ministry. 1st Year develops students with life skills and theological study via Laidlaw College. Students will walk into the 2nd Year equipped for a full year of practical ministry. Students will come out of the 2nd Year understanding how to run and work in ministry environments.

#### Streams

#### Outreach

Under Arise Care, students will experience ministry outside the four walls of the church. Students will partner with Arise Care in meeting the needs of the sick, poor, refugees & the imprisoned. This will involve the day-to-day outworking of organising Arise Care events and working with Arise Care's partners. Students can enrol in either the DipCS (Christian Leadership) or optional papers at Laidlaw College relevant to the stream in a bespoke study programme, such as a Bachelor of Theology. Students in this stream will also have the opportunity to go on a mission trip with one of the organisations we partner with. (The mission trip will be at an extra cost).

#### Pastoral

This stream runs within our pastoral teams (Kids, Intermediates, Youth, Young Adults, Adults and Families). Students will gain experience in running ministry areas through life groups, age group events, and training in pastoral care. Students can enrol in either the DipCS (Christian Leadership) or optional papers at Laidlaw College relevant to the stream in a bespoke study programme such as a Bachelor of Theology. Students in this stream will have the opportunity to attend a Pastoral Care 101 training day and supervision sessions with Mind Health).

#### Creative

Under the creative and services departments, students will grow their creative giftings. Areas include worship, production, design, videography, and photography. Students can enrol in either the DipCS (Christian Leadership) or optional papers at Laidlaw College relevant to the stream in a bespoke study programme such as a Bachelor of Theology. Students in this stream will have the opportunity to attend one relevant workshop or conference during the year to enhance learning.





## Certificate in Christian Ministry (Internship)\*

The Certificate is an entry-level programme for those who haven't studied at a tertiary level and/or who would like to start with the basics of the Bible and faith.

This course includes a Practical Ministry Internship and four taught courses: Discipleship; Encountering the Bible; Basics of Christian belief; and Faith in action. You will develop knowledge, skills and experience by connecting your own reflection the Christian faith with real-life practical contexts the Christian faith with real-life practical contexts, equipping you for service in the church.

Your core taught courses will be taught in block courses in Wellington through semester one and two. Weekly online tutorials will support you as you move through the semester and complete your assessments.

- 3 days per week and serving in a Friday or a Sunday team
- Run in partnership with Laidlaw College

## Diploma in Christian Studies (Christian Leadership)\*

The Diploma is designed to take students deeper into developing their biblical and theological understanding, their discipleship and their practical leadership. This course included a Practical Leadership Internship and four taught courses: Reading the Bible, Engaging theology, Formation, and Christian leadership and mission.

This course can form the first year of a full Bachelor of Theology with Laidlaw College or staircase into other study pathways.

Your core taught courses will be taught by distance learning, including the option to attend lectures either via Zoom or at a Laidlaw campus in Christchurch or Auckland. Regular online tutorials will support you as you move through the semester and complete your assessments.

Arise Night School is a one-year, part-time course designed to develop and release a new generation of ministers and leaders. Rooted in transformation, discipleship, and personal growth, this fully online program is purposefully structured to fit around the demands of busy lives — whether you're managing a business, working full-time, studying, parenting, or balancing multiple commitments.

Throughout the year, students engage in advanced biblical teaching and leadership development, equipping them to become effective disciples and influential leaders within their unique spheres.

The course runs over two semesters and is delivered through live online classes every Tuesday night from 7:00pm to 9:00pm. Teaching is led by experienced Arise pastors and leaders, combining in-depth Bible study with practical ministry training. In addition, students will have the opportunity to apply what they've learned through hands-on ministry experience in either a Friday or Sunday service.

Arise Night School is more than a course — it's a journey of calling, character, and capacity.


